Smaragdi Antonopoulou is a Professor of Biochemistry in the Department of Nutrition-Dietetics, School of Health Science and Education. She holds a degree in Chemistry and a Ph.D. in Biochemistry from the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens (NKUA). She has served as Rector, Vice-Rector for Financial Affairs and Development, Chair of the Department of Nutrition- Dietetics, Dean of the School of Health Science and Education, and Director of the Laboratory of Biology, Biochemistry, and Physiology of Humans and Microorganisms.
