Georgios Dedousis, Professor of Molecular Genetics and Nutrigenetics, has a Bachelor's Degree in Biology from the University of Patras, a Master's Degree from the University of Technology of Compiegne in France, and a Doctorate Degree from the Medical School of the Kapodistrian University of Athens. He has worked as a researcher with a Fulbright scholarship at the Harvard Medical School (Boston, USA). His research work consists of more than 370 publications, he has been cited internationally in more than 75,000 papers with an h-index of 107. In the period 2012-2016 he was a member of the University Council and in the period 2020-2024, he served as Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs and Quality Assurance. He has been the Vice-President of the Hellenic Foundation for Research and Innovation (H.F.R.I.) and has coordinated numerous research and educational programs. In 2018 he received the Gutenberg chair from the Strasbourg municipality. In 2019 he was awarded by Harokopio University for the distinction of being included in «The Highly Cited Researchers» list of the 6,000 most influential scientists worldwide, according to the impact of their work for the last 11 years.
