He holds a 4 year bachelor's degree from the Department of Geology of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, and a doctoral degree with specialization in Geostatistics in the Earth Sciences from the Department of Geological and Environmental Sciences of Stanford University. He has served as Dean of the Faculty of Engineering and Technology at CUT, and as Chair of the Department of Civil Engineering and Geomatics. Since 2020, he has been included in the top 2% of scientists worldwide, based on the raking list compiled every year by researchers at Stanford University and published by Elsevier.
